



Jack's Canyon is named after a breathtaking Waipara landmark adjacent to our Waipara winery. A natural waterway was diverted 50 years ago to prevent flooding of farmland and that small diversion is now a 60 metre canyon known as Jack's Canyon. A fence still spans the divide today.

#### TECHNICAL NOTES

#### CELLAR NOTES

Clean, pure fruit was harvest and received SO<sub>2</sub> in the vineyard at harvest. Once in the winery the juice was lightly fined and clarified for fruit retention. Slightly cloudy juice was racked to stainless steel tanks for fermentation, which was carried out by cultured yeast giving a cultured wine. After a small time on yeast lees this wine was blended and bottled in the Spring of 2010.

#### TASTING NOTES

Jack's Canyon Sauvignon Blanc is an elegant, mouthwatering style with delicate aromas of limes, grapefruit and tropical citrus. The palate is rich, yet reserved, awash with limes, citrus, mineral and lively acidity giving the wine a lingering, flavour filled finish. *Food: Enjoy with your favorite seafood or chicken dish.*
